AMUSEMENTS

§ 112.01 LICENSE REQUIRED.

No person, within the village, by himself or herself, his or her agent, or otherwise, shall establish, keep, or maintain in a place of public resort any billiard table; pool table; bowling alley; shooting gallery; table game; amusement device operated with a coin or slug; any device to produce or reproduce music, coin-operated or otherwise; or any place of amusement containing devices of like nature that is open to the public without first having obtained a license therefor.

■§ 112.02 FEE.

The annual license fee for any license, as enumerated in § 112.01, shall be \$5 for each place of business containing any item or device mentioned in § 112.04 and shall be payable in advance on May 1 of each year.

§ 112.03 APPLICATION.

Applications for such licenses shall be made in writing to the Village Clerk and shall state thereon the intended location of the place of business and the number and type of tables, alleys, or other amusement devices to be contained therein.

§ 112.04 HOURS OF OPERATION.

No person shall keep open, operate, or use any place of amusement mentioned in this subchapter between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 12:00 noon on Sundays, or between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 5:00 a.m. on all other days.
