Charlie Kennell: Kevin was present at 12.8.25 hearing in event to reach agreement. Total fines over 180 days were significant for two separate incidents. This meeting Colt discussed what court set in place: For the building there were charges for a structural engineer, fees to Colt, ect so roughly \$6500. There is no court filing fee due to this being municipal. The court gave Charlie until January 1, 2027, to pay this back interest free, if he does not comply, 9% interest will be tacked to \$6500.
